ORDINANCE NO. Z-26-

AN ORDINANCE amending the zoning map of the New Haven Plan Commission's jurisdictional area.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW HAVEN, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the area described as follows is hereby changed from A1; Agricultural to I1; Limited Industrial under the terms of Chapter 157 Title XV of the Code of the City of New Haven, Indiana:

All that part of the East Half of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 30 North, Range 14 East, Allen County, Indiana, lying South of the Norfolk Southern Railway Company (formerly The Wabash and St. Louis Railway Company) right-of-way, running through said Southeast Quarter.

Except: 0.817 acres taken for Right-of-Way purposes, per Document #2017061572 as found in the Office of the Recorder of Allen County, Indiana.

Containing 4.807 acres, more or less.

and the symbols of the City of New Haven Zoning Map as established by Section 157.201 of Title XV of the Code of the City of New Haven, Indiana is hereby changed accordingly.

SECTION 2. If a written commitment is a condition of the Plan Commission's recommendation for the adoption of the rezoning, or if a written commitment is modified and approved by the Common Council as part of the zone map amendment, that the written commitment is hereby approved and is hereby incorporated by reference.

ORDINANCE NO. Z-26-

**AN ORDINANCE amending the zoning map of the New
Haven Plan Commission's jurisdictional area.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW HAVEN,
INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the area described as follows is hereby changed from I2; General Industrial to a PUD; Planned Unit Development under the terms of Chapter 157 Title XV of the Code of the City of New Haven, Indiana:

Part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 30 North, Range 13 East, in Allen County Indiana, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the West Quarter Corner of Section 11, being a rebar within the SR930 median; thence North 0 degrees 43 minutes 19 seconds West on the West Line of the Northwest Quarter, a distance of 102.80 feet to the northerly right-of-way of Lincoln Highway, being 35.00 feet from Alignment "24WB" of INDOT Project 365, with the right-of-way granting document recorded in Book 543, Page 132, of the Allen County Recorder's Office, and being the Point of Beginning; thence continue North 0 degrees 43 minutes 19 seconds West on the West Line, a distance of 516.43 feet to the south right-of-way of the Norfolk Southern (formerly Wabash) Railroad; thence North 89 degrees 24 minutes 14 seconds East on the southern railroad right-of-way, a distance of 909.6 feet to a steel bar at the northwest corner of the parcel defined by Document 204024241 of the Recorder's Office; thence South 0 degrees 39 minutes 46 seconds East on the westerly line of the said parcel, a distance of 390.24 feet to the northwest corner of the parcel defined by Document 89-023338; thence continue South 0 degrees 39 minutes 46 seconds East on the westerly line of the parcel, a distance of 149.27 feet to the northerly right-of-way of Lincoln Highway, the said right-of-way point being 35.00 feet distant from Alignment "24WB"; thence South 88 degrees 33 minutes 35 seconds West on the right-of-way and not parallel with Alignment "24WB", a distance of 160.09 feet to a point of curvature; thence 188.90 feet on the 30.00 feet right-of-way as granted in Book 539, Page 542, of the Recorder's Office, being an arc to the right with a radius of 3,789.82 feet, to a right-of-way monument at the Point of Reverse Curve, with the arc having a long chord bearing of North 86 degrees 58 minutes 45 seconds West and a long chord distance of 188.88 feet; thence 278.72 feet on the 30.00 feet right-of-way that parallels Alignment "24WB", being an arc to the left with a radius of 3,850.26 feet to a deflection in the right-of-way, the said arc having a long chord bearing of North 87 degrees 37 minutes 30 seconds West and a long chord distance of 278.66 feet, thence North 00 degrees 43 minutes 19 seconds West on the right-of-way, a distance of 5.00 feet; thence westerly 282.43 feet on the 35.00 feet right-of-way, being an arc to the left with a radius of 3,855.26 feet, with the long chord bearing of South 88 degrees 12 minutes 04 seconds West and a long chord distance of 282.37 feet, to the Point of Beginning, containing 10.958 acres,

and the symbols of the City of New Haven Zoning Map as established by Section 157.201 of Title XV of the Code of the City of New Haven, Indiana is hereby changed accordingly.

SECTION 2.
